We Gather From House to House

The first century, believers gathered from house to house. It was their lifestyle and tradition; and it appears that the New Testament writers assumed their readers understood the structure. Throughout the New Testament there are regular references to believers who gathered in homes (Romans 16:3-5; 1Corinthians 16:19;

Colossians 4:15; Philemon 1:2).

How you gather with other believers is significant. Your method of gathering has tremendous impact on you, and the purposes of the Lord in the earth. There is a difference between being a spectator and a participant.

Historically, the idea of 'going to church'

and meeting in dedicated buildings today did not begin until around 312 AD. It was then that believers moved from the simple gathering in homes, where they ministered to each other (Romans 15:14; 1Corinthians 14:26; Hebrews 10:24-25), into dedicated buildings where they sat and listened as spectators. When this system of worship began, it took the ministry out of the hands of the God's people, and put it into the hands of professional clergy.

In New Life Ministries International, we believe that God is restoring the values and structure of first century Christianity. His desire is to release the saints to fulfill His purposes in the earth. Gathering from house to house is not just a move from 'big building church' to 'living room church', but rather, it is a it lays the groundwork for the saints of God to do the work of ministry (Ephesians 4:11-12).



New Life gathers as a body of believers on the first, third and fifth Sundays. The other weeks are open for gathering from house to house.

Believers are edifying, exhorting and comforting each other. They are becoming stronger and more confident in their walk of faith.
